Roger recently was a keynote speaker and conducted workshops for the National Employment Support Association, Australia. Roger is a member of the VRA Standards Committee and the Advisory Panel of the UK Rehabilitation Council

Dave Costello:

Dave has worked as an OT for 18 years in mental health. After working as the lead clinician for the above pilot, he has, in partnership with Roger, delivered Job Retention Case Management Training throughout the UK. Dave has also recently been assisting employers to develop better mental health promotion strategies for staff, and has developed 'Work-Place Facilitator' training for, among others, Swansea Borough Council and Dyfed & Powys Police. He is also a guest lecturer in OT at the University of West England.
